To partition 2 and 3- digit numbers to help with addition and subtraction.

To read and write times shown on an analogue and digital clock.

To secure multiplication and division facts for 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

To organise data into tables, charts and graphs.

Science

Plan a fair test to see what plants need, to grow.

Label and name the parts of a plant.

Recognise that we eat different parts of a plant (leaf, stem, root, and seed).

Learn about how plants adapt to their environments (desert and rainforest plants).

Understand how important plants are to animals living in the same environment (rainforest and our school garden).

PE Improve our skills when using bats and balls.

Work co-operatively with a partner and create short dance phrases.
