Year 2 Home Learning – Summer 1

Find a minibeast in its natural habitat and draw or paint a picture of it. You could use sketching pencils, paints, crayons, felt tip pens or chalks.



Go on a 'bug hunt' in your garden. How many different minibeasts can you find? Record your findings in a tally chart and then put the results on to a bar graph.



Write some descriptive sentences about minibeasts. Try to use at least one adjective in every sentence and try to put a verb and an adverb in your sentence too.
E.g. The beautiful blue butterfly fluttered quickly around the small garden.



Read for 10 minutes four times a week.
Practise spelling the days of the week and the months of the year, remember they begin with a capital letter.
Count forwards and backwards in 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's up to and from 100. Use this counting to solve multiplication problems from the 2, 5 or 10 times table.

Go on to Purple Mash. Go to 'Topics' then 'Mathematics' and then play the 'Fraction Wall' game. Try Challenge A first. You could also try 'Fractonio's Pizzeria'. Your log in and password are in your learning journals.



Make a 3D model of your favourite minibeast.



Create a fact file of the Minibeast.
