Design a game that reflects your favourite traditional stories. Remember to include rules and an explanation of how to play the game.



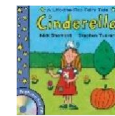
Write a postcard or letter in the role of a story character from a traditional tale. Tell someone about something you have done or somewhere you have been.
