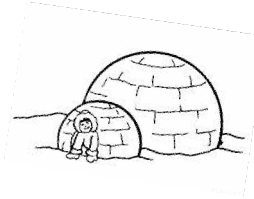


# Hot and Cold

| <p>Create an animal mask. Be as creative as you can. Adding ears, whiskers, trunks, beaks.</p>   | <p>Create your own Top Trump cards for animals that live in different climates. Think about the different categories. Record into a tally and transfer onto a block graph.</p>  |
| <p>Do 'ice cube' colour mixing - add a drop of food colouring (primary colours: red, yellow, blue) to water in an ice cube tray and freeze. Explore the cubes as they melt, mixing them together to make new colours. What colours did you make? Take photos.</p>  | <p>Can you find a story that has a 'Cold/Winter' 'Hot/Summer' theme? Read it, get someone to take a photo of you reading then write a book review. Remember to include your favourite part and who else might enjoy this story.</p>  | <p>Find out and write 6 facts about Your favourite continent. Remember to add detail.</p>   | <p>Practise your 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables so that you can give an answer instantly. E.g. What is 4 x 5?
