## Is there anything out there?

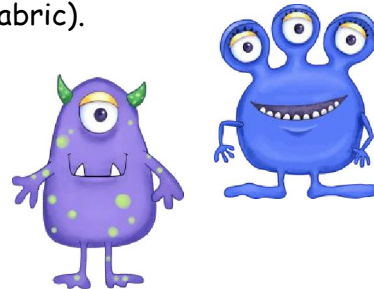
### Year 2 – Home Learning Spring 1



Now we know the continents we need to learn the name and location of the 5 oceans. You can practise this using the Purple Mash game you used to learn the continents. If you want to you could also find out some facts about the different oceans and then you can share them with us all.



Use your imagination to make a collage picture or a model of what you think an alien might look like. Try to use as many different kinds of material as you can (tin foil, paper, plastic, fabric).



There are so many fantastic stories and poems about aliens. Visit the library or look on your book shelf and if you find a good one please bring it in to share with us all.



Aliens are very good at counting forwards and backwards. Practise counting forwards and backwards to and from 100 in 2's, 5's and 10's. Try 3's and 4's. Practise your 2x, 5x and 10x tables. Continue to try to read for 10 minutes four times a week.



You are going to meet some aliens on another planet. What ten things will you take as a present for them? Draw them in a gift box.



Put 12 aliens on 3 planets. There must be a different number of aliens on each planet. How many different ways are there to do this?



What else could be out there other than aliens? Investigate . . . . . satellites, space debris? Make a 3D model of something you might see floating around in space.
