- Hooks - 10 per pack

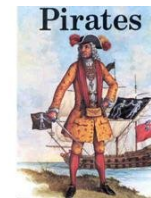


Change the number of pirates going on the voyage and work out how many packets of each item they will need.

Find a pirate book, read it and write a book review of it.

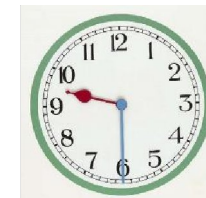


Include the name of the book, the author and illustrator, and a description of what the book is about.
