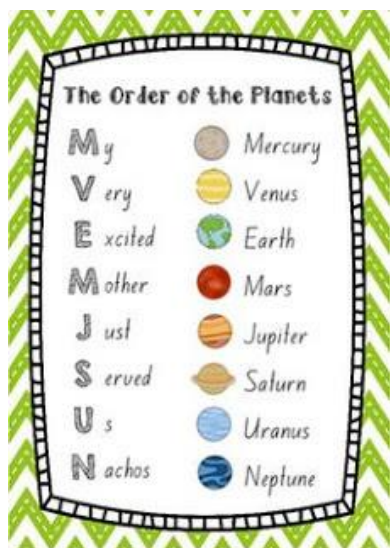

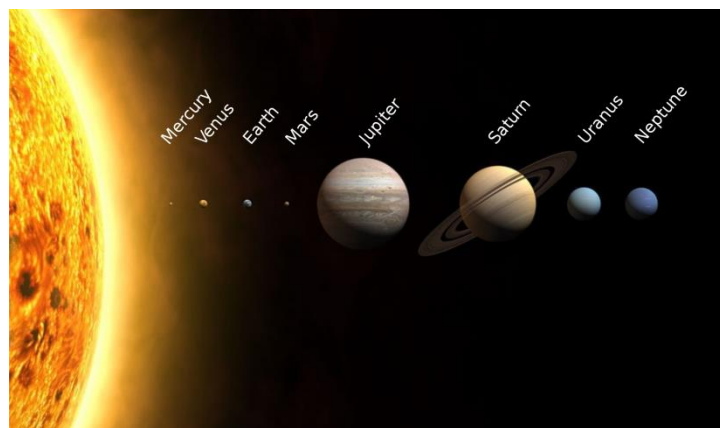

Key Vocabulary;

Astronaut - a person who is trained to travel in a spacecraft

Crater - a bowl shaped hole on the surface of something

Gravity - the downward force that keeps us on the Earth

Moon - reflected by light from the sun, visible at night

Orbit - the curved path taken around a planet or the sun

Planets - a natural object outside the Earth's atmosphere that orbits a star

Rotates - turn round in a circle

Solar System - collection of 8 planets, the Sun, the moons and stars

Star - huge glowing ball of gas
