Find out what they are and then think if the UK was to have a natural wonder what would it be? Write an explanation explaining your reasons why.</p> 	<p><b>Be a Mathematician</b></p> <p>Continue to practise counting forwards and backwards to and from 100 in 2's, 5's and 10's. Then try 3's and 4's. Practise your 2x, 5x and 10x tables.</p> <p>Keep practising your number bonds to 10, 20 and 100 and double and half facts with numbers to 20.</p>
<p><b>Be an Artist</b></p> <p>Create a collage or painting using one of the wonders of the world as your inspiration.</p> 	<p><b>Be a Scientist and a Mathematician</b></p> <p>Make a set of Top Trump cards based on animals in one of the seven continents.</p> 	<p><b>Be a Reader</b></p> <p>Many stories and poems are set in different parts of the World.
