

Year 2 - Home Learning Summer Term 2 Week 5 (29.6.20 - 3.7.20)

This week the activities can be done in any order except if your child is a key worker child and then they need to be done in order 1 - 5 as this is the order we will be doing them in school. **Activities 2 & 3** can be done together in the same day if you wish as can **Activities 4 & 5**.

This week our work will focus on life in a castle and we will write a diary account and a job advert. We will also have some fun researching and preparing for our writing.



Activity 1 - Spellings

Activity 2 - Research and role play

Activity 3 is writing a diary so this activity is to help you to prepare for doing that.

Research the people who **lived** in castles. Then chose one person and think about what it would have been like to be that person and what your life would be like. You can talk through your ideas with an adult or make some notes to help you write your diary or you can start your diary and then finish it the next day.

Activity 3 - Writing a diary account

Who might write a **diary**? What does a **diary** tell us?

Do you or anyone you know keep a **diary**?

A diary is a personal piece of writing; it should share your experiences and your feelings.

You are writing a diary in role as somebody who lived in a castle so you need to think about what they would do with their days. How they felt, what made them happy or sad or excited.....

It is very important that you include emotions in your diary.

Activity 4 - Research and role play

Activity 5 is writing a job advert so this activity is to help you to prepare for doing that.

Recap on the people who **worked** in a castle.

Imagine you are somebody working in a castle.

You might be a chambermaid, a guard or a knight, a jester or musician, a cook or even the person that emptied/removed the toilet rubbish!

Write a list of the jobs you do in a day/night

Activity 5 - Writing a job advert

Where would you find an **advert** for a job? What important things does a job advert need to include? What skills will the person need for the job you are advertising?

Write a job advert to advertise for a new chambermaid, guard, knight, jester, musician, cook or any other interesting jobs you've learnt about in castles. Use your ideas from yesterday to help you.
