The South Wootton village sign was put up in June 1978.



A 17 year old boy designed the sign. His name was Paul Hillard.

He won a competition when he was at school in King's Lynn.

His design has special things from South Wootton on it. There are carvings of two members of a well-known family, the Old Hall, the parish church and its Norman font.

The sign cost about £250. People in South Wootton gave money to pay for the sign.
