


Year 2 - English

Begin to think about what the book is about. Tell a grown up what the book is about.</p> <hr/> <p><u>Animal Alphabet</u> Can you think of animals whose names begin with every letter of the alphabet? e.g. A alligator B bear C</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Tuesday</p> <p>Look at the picture of the gorilla.
