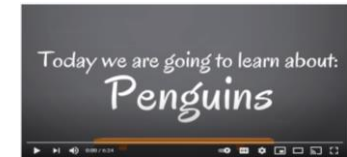

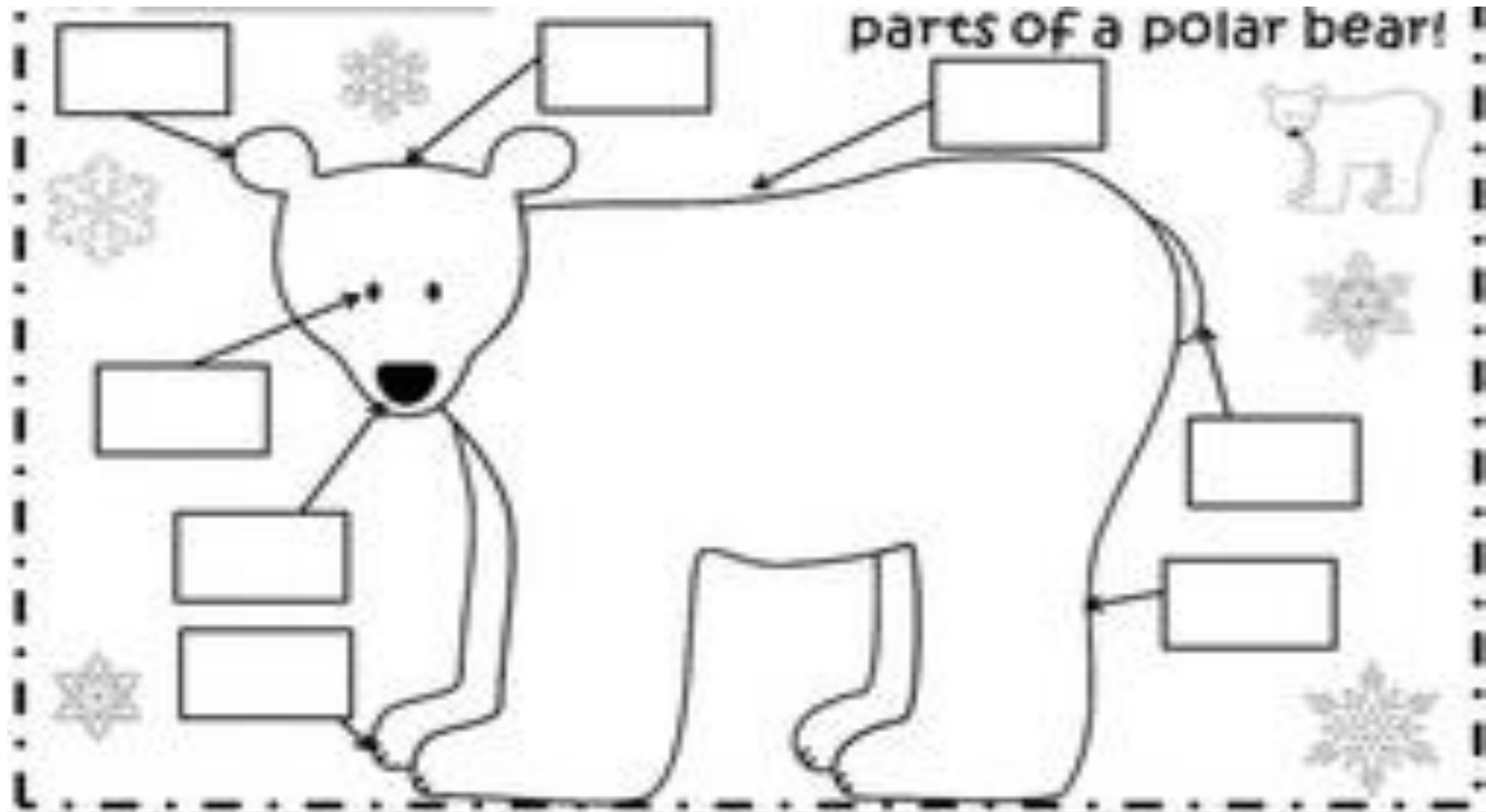
### Friday: PE
