


<p>This week's English work is based around the book, 'Handa's Surprise' by Eileen Browne.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Monday</b></p> <p><b>Watch Tapestry video of story being read.</b> <b>Watch Tapestry teaching video.</b></p> <p>Can you retell the story 'Handa's Surprise'? What happens at the beginning of the story? What happens in the middle? What happens at the end?</p> <p>Draw a story 'S' to retell the story. Can you annotate your story 'S' with key words?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Tuesday</b></p> <p><b>Watch Tapestry teaching video.</b></p> <p>Today we are going to start to change the story. Look at the beginning of the story. What else could be inside the basket? Toys? Special objects? Can you think of any ideas?</p> <p>Find a box/bag/basket at home and fill it with 7 objects. You could choose to fill it with toys or just a selection of special objects.</p> <p>Draw a basket with the 7 objects inside.</p> <p>Label the objects. Can you add an adjective in front of each object to describe it?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Wednesday</b></p> <p><b>Watch Tapestry teaching video. Story structure support sheet also provided.</b></p> <p>Today we are going to begin to write the new version of the story. If you would like to you could create a little book to write your story in, or you can just write it on a piece of paper.</p> <p>Write the title of the story, remembering capital letters.</p> <p>Write the beginning of the story, using the structure provided.</p> <p>e.g.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Rosie's Surprise</u></p> <p><u>Rosie</u> put seven exciting toys in a basket for her friend, <u>Sarah</u>. She will be surprised, thought <u>Rosie</u> as she set off for <u>Sarah's</u> house. I wonder which toy she'll like best?</p>		<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Thursday/Friday</b></p> <p><b>Watch Tapestry teaching video</b></p> <p>Continue to write the story. E.g.</p> <p>Will she like the <u>fast blue racing car</u> or the <u>soft cuddly teddy</u>?</p> <p>Will she like the <u>noisy bells</u> or the <u>angry green dinosaur</u>?</p> <p>Will she like the <u>pretty wooden girl</u> or the <u>colourful marbles</u>? Will she like the smart Lego man?</p> <p>Which toy will Sarah like best?</p> <p>"Hello Sarah" said Rosie. "I've brought you a surprise." "Tangerines!" said Sarah. "My favourite fruit." "That is a surprise!"</p> <p>Or if you would like to, you could change the end of the story too?</p>
