We will learn number bonds to 100 and use these facts to help us complete addition and subtraction number sentences

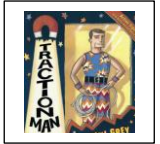
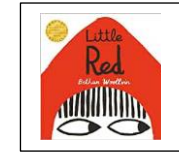
## English
