#### Attendance update

Attendance remains a focus for improvement. The school now has to report weekly attendance to the Department for Education. There are termly meetings with the Attendance Officer who analyses the data and questions individual pupils where the attendance drops below 90%. The Local Authority have expressed concern about the number of holidays being taken in term time. They have updated their attendance guidance and it will now be important to note that

If you take a holiday in term time any future absence will be unauthorised without supporting medical evidence.

If in any six week period you have 9 sessions (4.5 days) unauthorised absence you can receive a Fixed Penalty Notice.

Appointments taken in school time will need to be evidenced and it will no longer be possible to collect a child straight after afternoon register and still receive their mark.


