Attendance remains a focus for improvement. The school now has to report weekly attendance to the Department for Education. There are termly meetings with the Attendance Officer who analyses the data and questions individual pupils where the attendance drops below 90%. The Local Authority have expressed concern about the number of holidays being taken in term time. We have now had 31 holiday requests that have or will qualify for a Fixed Penalty Notice.

Coronation Coins

He will be coming into school next week to present these to members of the Pupil Parliament who will then given them out to all the children.


