Dear Parents

As part of the curriculum, all children will have access to a range of teaching and learning experiences both within and beyond the classroom.

1. Local walks and visits

Through the year, your child may go on local trips and visits to enhance the curriculum. Examples of such trips might be a local walk or visiting another school for a joint activity. Any school trips will always comply with LA regulations on safety and the recommended ratio of adults to children. For trips beyond the local area, a separate letter will always be sent.

2. Term time absences

The Government remains very clear that no child should miss school apart from in exceptional circumstances and schools must continue to take steps to reduce absence to support children's attainment. Please ensure you have read the letter about attendance.

3. Media

On occasion, the local newspapers may be invited to take photographs to publicise activities in or outside school. These then may appear on the website of the publication.

4. Forest Schools

All the children will have the opportunity to join in with Forest School sessions on the school site with our trained Forest School leader, Mrs Jacqui Patnell. Sessions may include using tools and making fires. Photographs of Forest School sessions may be posted on Tapestry and the website.

5. Food tasting

As part of the curriculum, e.g. Art, Design & Technology or Science, your child may sometime handle and taste foodstuffs. If your child has any food allergies/dietary requirements, please would you detail these on the consent form.

In order to celebrate the exciting and creative things our school does, we put photographs and examples of children's work on our school website. Please be aware that we will not name children in photographs. The work that is showcased will be named but will not have photographs of the children with it.

7. School Dog

We have a school dog called Denis. He spends time in the classrooms with the children and is available as a therapy dog for children if needed.
