Key Questions:-

Numeracy

The children will be learning about fractions (1/2, $\frac{1}{4}$, 1/3 and equivalent fractions)

They will be learning how to tell the time on an analogue clock.

They will learn about position and direction and be able to describe position.

They will be recording, interpreting and presenting data.

Year Two, Summer Term

Art → Design

In Art we will be learning about the artist Hokusai and we will be creating our own printing materials.

In DT we will be finding out about lighthouses and we will be designing and making our own lighthouses.

English

The children will be learning how to write an explanation text. They will find out about the life cycle of a turtle and create an explanation text about turtles.

Our narrative unit focuses on fantasy writing and the children will create their own fantasy stories.

Later in the term will be looking at persuasive letters

and postcards in role.

Science

We will be learning about both human and animal life cycles. We will be learning how to look after our Planet and the impact pollution has on the environment.

We will also be looking at Seasonal Change.

History focus

We will be learning about Grace Darling and how our lives today have been shaped by events and people from the past.

We will be finding out about Victorian Seaside holidays and how it has changed from holidays today. We will be learning how to use timelines.

PE

In P.E. we will be learning skills for striking and fielding games and different athletics techniques.

Computing

Our focus will be on using 2Paint a Picture programme on Purple Mash and the children will use 2Paint a Picture to create art based upon the style of various different artists.

Music

Children will create a short musical pattern inspired by the sounds of the Ocean.

We will also be learning how to perform songs using creativity and expression.

PSHE

We will follow the JIGSAW Programme, 'Relationships/friendships' and 'Relationships and Sex Education' (more information will follow about this nearer the time).
