Write a postcard

Message in a bottle

You are marooned on an island and you need to be rescued.

Write a message to put in a bottle and send out to sea.

If somebody finds it what will you want or need them to know?

How will they find you?



Silent letters

Island has a silent **s**. It is there but we don't say it or hear it.

Sometimes a **g**, **k**, **b** and **w** are silent in words. We see them but we don't say them or hear them.

Look in books and in a dictionary to see if you can find some words with silent letters in.



Word game

Play a word game with someone in your house.

You could play Scrabble or Hangman or I Spy.

See the attached reading comprehensions about 'The Palm Island'. There is a lot of new vocabulary so discuss the meaning of any words you are unsure of with an adult in your house.

White, **Lime** and **Gem** book band readers should do Paper 3.
