





Please do not feel that you have to do all of these activities. There is a variety so you have a choice.

<p>Trapped on an island!</p> <p>Imagine you are trapped on an island. What can you find on your island or in your luggage that you could use to make a shelter? Build your shelter in your garden and send us a picture of you inside it.</p> 	<p>Draw an imaginary island</p> <p>How are you going to survive on your island? You need fresh water to drink and food. Draw a map of your island showing the features it has for example, forests, rivers, streams, lakes, paths, roads, mountains and swamps. Which of these will help you to survive and how? Make your map as colourful as you can and give your island a name.</p> 	<p>Strange creatures</p> <p>You have discovered some unusual animals living on your island and make friends with them.
